# Itinerary

## DAY ONE: FRIDAY, JUNE 25, 2027

- Departure via scheduled airline service to Berlin, Germany

## DAY TWO: SATURDAY, JUNE 26

- Arrive in Berlin
- Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to the awaiting motorcoach for a transfer into Berlin
- Take a panoramic introductory tour of Berlin's highlights and a Spree River Cruise (explore Berlin's magnificent architectural treasures and experience the city's amazing transformation by boat on a one-hour cruise on the River Spree) en route
- Late afternoon hotel check-in
- Evening Welcome Dinner, and overnight

## DAY THREE: SUNDAY, JUNE 27

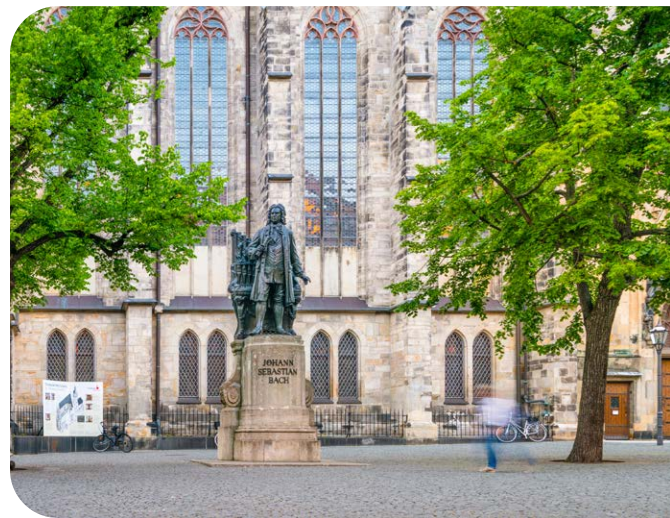
- Breakfast at the hotel
- **Morning rehearsal**
- Half-day sightseeing of the eastern sector of Berlin with its famous Unter den Linden Strasse, (iconic boulevard of linden trees), the Russian War Memorial, what remains of "the wall," and "Checkpoint Charley" as we pass into the western sector to experience Kurfurstendamm Strasse, home to some of Berlin's most luxurious stores. Also see Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church, Berlin Dom, Reichstag, etc.
- Lunch, on own
- **Afternoon venue soundcheck rehearsal**
- **Performance in Berlin at Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Chapel**
- Evening dinner, and overnight

## DAY FOUR: MONDAY, JUNE 28

- Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out
- Excursion to Halle to visit the birthplace of Händel. In addition to the composer's personal effects, the museum houses an exhibition of musical instruments and history of music in the region
- Lunch, on own
- Continue to Leipzig for an orientation tour of the city. Visit Augustusplatz, one of the largest city squares in Germany. Surrounded by significant buildings, this square is the cultural heart of Leipzig. Notable landmarks include the Gewandhaus concert hall. Also see St. Nicholas Church, a historic site known for its role in the peaceful demonstrations leading to the fall of the Berlin Wall. Drive by Leipzig University, Founded in 1409. Leipzig University is one of the oldest universities in the world. The striking Paulinum, built on the site of the former St. Paul's Church, blends modern architecture with historical element
- Continue to Leipzig for dinner (on own), and overnight

## DAY FIVE: TUESDAY, JUNE 27

- Breakfast at the hotel
- A guided tour of Leipzig includes entrance to St. Thomas Church (famous because Bach was the organist and choirmaster here, and it is the home of the St. Thomas Boys Choir, one of the most famous



in the world). Also visit the Bach Museum. The reconstructed Bose House stands in the shadow of the Thomaskirche. It was once the home of the Bach family and now contains the largest Bach archives in Germany, as well as many mementos of the composer

- Recital in Thomaskirche
- Lunch, on own
- Afternoon venue soundcheck rehearsal
- Performance in Leipzig at St. Nikolaikirche
- Evening dinner, and overnight

#### DAY SIX: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 30

- Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out
- Morning transfer to Prague
- Lunch, on own
- Enjoy a guided tour of Prague. Visit the Castle District, where entrance is included to Hradcany Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, the Golden Lane, and Daliborka Tower. Also visit Lobkovicz Palace with its large music archive containing works by over five hundred composers and musicians.
- Evening dinner (on own), and overnight

---

#### DAY SEVEN: THURSDAY, JULY 1

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Step into the enchanting Old Town of Prague, where history breathes through cobblestone streets and timeless architecture. Surrounded by colorful facades and adorned with elegant spires, the square is a living testament to Prague's rich heritage. One of the focal points of Old Town Square is the magnificent Astronomical Clock, a marvel of medieval engineering and craftsmanship. A short stroll from the Old Town Square leads to the Jewish Quarter, a district steeped in history and cultural significance. The Jewish Square houses synagogues, a cemetery, and the iconic Old Jewish Town Hall. Explore the Spanish Synagogue, an architectural gem adorned with intricate Moorish details, and reflect on the complex history of the Jewish community in Prague
- Lunch, on own
- Afternoon venue soundcheck rehearsal
- Performance in Prague at St. Nicholas Church
- Evening Farewell Dinner, and overnight

---

#### DAY EIGHT: FRIDAY, JULY 2

- Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out
- Transfer to the Prague Airport for return flight
